

PM should show the courage to investigate the Rs 20,000 cr in Adani group of companies: Patole

Mumbai, March 31 (UNI) : Maharashtra Pradesh Congress Committee(MPPCC) President Nana Patole on Friday said that Prime Minister Narendra Modi should show the courage to investigate the Rs 20,000 crore in Adani group of companies.

In the last 9 years, the Modi government has worked only for his friends and helped them by putting public money in their pockets. All government enterprises in the country, contracts

have been awarded only to Adani. Rs 20,000 crore have been invested in the Adani group through shell companies. Where did this money come from, he asked.

On today the Pradesh Congress held press conferences in all the districts headquarters of the state to expose the Modi-Adani corrupt alliance.

While he was speaking in Thane, Legislature party leader Balasaheb Thorat in Ahmednagar, former Chief Minister

Ashok Chavan in Parbhani, Prithviraj Chavan was in Pune, while Vidhan Parishad group leader Satej Patil held a press conference in Sangli among others leaders of party organised such conferences in rest of the districts.

Mr Patole further said that thieves like Nirav Modi, Lalit Modi, Vijay Mallya stole people's money and fled abroad.

A "Stage Stability" certificate from the concerned contractor as well as from the Public Works Department of the stage erected for the meeting should be submitted to the police among others.

Situation is under control, police arrest 7 suspects in connection clashes

Chhatrapati Sambhajnagar, March 31 (UNI) : City police have launched combing operation and arrested seven suspected accused in connection of Wednesday mid night tension prevailed after two group clashes at Kiradpura locality in city, police said.

Police also registered cases against 400 to 500 persons and formed eight teams to nab the culprits.

Combing operation will continue today to arrest the accused who were involved in the clashes.

During the tension rioters set ablaze 16 vehicles including 13 of police. Also, some policemen also injured in stone pelting incident during the clashes.

Police said that situation is under control and appealed to peoples do not believe on any rumors.

Heavy police force deployed in the trouble torn areas of Kiradpura.

Meanwhile, allegation and counter allegation are seen between ruling party and opposition parties political leaders.UBT

senior leader Chandrakant Khaire accused that Chhatrapati Sambhajnagar AIMIM Imitaz Jaleel is responsible for the tension and demanded his arrest.

He also alleged that state home minister Devendra Fadnavis is mastermind behind the tension.

However, BJP leaders including State cabinet minister Atul Save and Union minister of state for finance Dr Bhagwat Karad denied Khaire's charges and said that Mr Khaire lost his mental balance.

Credai Pune-Metro reaction on the stamp duty and ready reckoner rates announcement

Pune, March 31 (UNI) : Today's announcement of the state Govt to keep unchanged the stamp duty and ready reckoner rates are a welcome move and a big relief for the real estate industry.

Says Ranjit Naiknavare, "Credai Pune-Metro had made various representations, recommendations and pleas before the state Govt, CM, DCM and top officials at IGR to re-evaluate and rationalise RR and and to not increase stamp duty rates.

Today's announcement will have a much required positive effect on the real estate industry and help it grow, in turn helping in economy and employment also. We hope with the support of all stakeholders, Credai Pune metro will continue to voice the industry opinion for the common benefit of all including the home buyers."

KMT employees on indefinite strike for 7th pay commission

Kolhapur, March 31 (UNI) : Employees, including drivers and conductors of city bus service, of Kolhapur Municipal Transport (KMT) owned by Kolhapur Municipal Corporation (KMC), on Friday took to agitation- with indefinite strike from Friday for their various pending demands, including implementation of 7th pay commission recommendations.

City bus service in the city and adjoining suburbs, were totally standstill and disrupted from the morning, which affected the passengers. About 60 to 70 city bus could not come out from KMT's main workshop following striking employees staging demonstrations in front of the gate of workshop. Nishikant Sarnaik, president of Municipal Transport Workers Union saying KMT administration has neglected their demands while union had already given a notice to administration about their pending demands and had warned to take decision on their demands till March 30 so there was no other alternate except to call an indefinite strike.

Three days after BJP MP's death, Pune bypoll query irks Ajit Pawar

Mumbai, March 31 : NCP's Leader of Opposition in the Maharashtra Assembly, Ajit Pawar, was annoyed on Friday over a query as to when will the Pune Lok Sabha bypoll take place to fill the seat vacated after the demise of sitting BJP MP, Girish Bapat (72), who passed away after a long illness on March 29.

To a query on Congress leader Vijay Wadetiwar's claim that the party would contest the seat, Pawar almost erupted, saying: "It's been hardly three days since Bapat passed away, and all you are thinking about is the bypoll... Are there any human sentiments left?"

"What is the rush for holding the by-election? Is there no humanity left now? Maharashtra has some traditions... People will question whether they (politicians) have a heart and soul," Pawar said.

Pune MP and senior BJP leader Bapat passed away on March 29,

following a prolonged illness, plunging the state party into grief.

Barely a day after Bapat's funeral, speculation has started in the political circles whether the Election Commission of India (ECI) would conduct a bypoll to fill up his seat, and which parties would be the contenders.

This would be barely a year before the scheduled Lok Sabha elections of 2024, and some people are even guessing whether the by-election could be timed with the Karnataka Assembly polls scheduled on May 10.

Sinde-Fadnavis govt has committed sin of cutting right funds of backward classes: Patil

Mumbai, March 31 (UNI) : After many initiatives like targeting opposition party representatives, suspending the works approved by the Maha Vikas Aghadi government, now the Sinde-Fadnavis government is committing the sin of cutting the right funds of the backward classes, says NCP state president Jayant Patil on Friday.

The current government has made a big cut in the provision made by the Maha Vikas Aghadi government for the welfare schemes of the backward classes in the last budget.

Mr Patil also said in his tweet that many schemes of the backward classes have been affected.

The provision of Dr Babasaheb Ambedkar Social Development Yojana in the original budget from 1200 crores to 840 crores, he has also drawn attention to the reduction in the provision of Dr Babasaheb Ambedkar's memorial at Indu Mill, the provision of Rs 100 crore in the original budget of the 'Stand Up India' scheme has been reduced to Rs 10 crore, he added.
